**This Sunday is the Solemnity of Pentecost:** This feast of the descent of the Holy Spirit can be seen as the birthday of the Church. It also marks the end of the Easter Season. Ordinary time recommences on Monday with week 7. Weekday readings are from year 2 and Sunday readings are from year B.

**Confirmation Mass:** Congratulations to those from our parishes who received the Sacrament of Confirmation from Bishop Bosco last Thursday. The Mass was a wonderful celebration and we continue to pray for the newly-confirmed. It was lovely to welcome out new bishop to our parish.

**May Rosary:** May is traditionally a month with a particular emphasis on Our Lady. Continuing on Sundays throughout May at 9:40am our children will lead a short celebration of one decade of the Glorious Mysteries of the Rosary in our parish church.
