**Bishop of Clifton:** On Wednesday Canon Bosco MacDonald is due to be ordained and installed as the 10<sup>th</sup> Bishop of Clifton at our Cathedral. The Mass, which begins at 12:00 noon, should be available at <a href="https://cliftoncathedral.org/stream">https://cliftoncathedral.org/stream</a>. We pray for our new bishop, and also for Bishop Declan. We thank him for his ministry as our bishop and wish him a happy and blessed retirement. Anyone wishing to contribute to a **diocesan retirement gift to Bishop Declan** is welcome to do so via the collection box at the back of the church this weekend or via the digital collection plate. Donations can also be left at the parish office in clearly marked envelopes. All donations must be received by 15<sup>th</sup> May.

**Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord** is this Thursday and is a Holy Day of Obligation. There will two Masses on Thursday at 10:00am and 7:00pm in our parish church. The children of our primary school will be present for the 10:00am Mass. There will also be Mass at 10:00am at Saint Joseph, Stonehouse and at 12:00 noon at the Annunciation, Woodchester. The days between the solemnities of the Ascension and Pentecost (on Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> May) are seen as a particular time to ask for a fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit as we remember the Blessed Virgin Mary gathered with other disciples of Jesus between these two events in the Upper Room. This is often seen as being the first Novena.

**Car Show at Saint Rose's:** The Wheelnuts Classic Car Show is one of the biggest charity events in Saint Rose's calendar, and takes place in the school grounds this Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> May (11:00am – 4:00pm).
