Change of Parish Priest: As has been announced over recent weeks Father Gary is being appointed as parish priest of Saint Peter's, Gloucester, and he will leave our three parishes on 27th August. Father Eugene Campbell, currently at Holy Family, Patchway, Bristol, is being appointed as the new parish priest and his first weekend will be 6th/7th September.

Farewell Celebration for Father Gary this Thursday 21st August beginning with Mass at 7:00pm and continuing in the parish hall. The refreshments after Mass this Sunday will be more elaborate than normal, also celebrating Father Gary's farewell, especially for those unable to be present on the Thursday evening.

Feasts and Anniversaries: This **Wednesday** is the anniversary in 1857 of the opening of our parish church. It is also the feast of Saint Bernard and we remember to pray for the Bernardine Sisters at Brownshill. **Saturday** is the feast of Saint Rose of Lima and we remember to pray for Saint Rose's School on that day. It is also the anniversary of the death of our former parish priest Canon Tom Curtis Hayward. **Tuesday 26th August** is the feast of Blessed Dominic of the Mother of God. He was a Passionist priest from Italy who felt a strong calling to minister in England which he did with much energy, enthusiasm and love. Saint John Henry Newman was received into the Church by him, and held Blessed Dominic in high regard. He was instrumental in the foundation of our church at Woodchester. Mass on Tuesday 26th August will be 9:30am at Woodchester.

Glastonbury Pilgrimage on Sunday 7th September with the theme 'Mary, Woman of Hope'. There will be a coach leaving Stroud at 8:50am (with other pickups at Gloucester at 8:05am and Tuffley at 8:25am). **These times have changed from last week's newsletter.** The coach is due to leave Glastonbury at 4:45pm for the return journey. The cost will be £10.00 per adult (£5.00 per child) and will be collected on the coach. There are sheets to sign in our churches if you would like to reserve a place or contact the parish office.
